



# Karoonda Area School Uniform Policy



The essence of Karoonda Area School's Uniform Policy involves some choice of clothing within the traditional colours of the school, bottle green, white and black.

A comprehensive review during Term 4 2020 indicated a preference for a set uniform with limited choice of colour and garment with a new emblem to acknowledge the amalgamation of East Murray Area School and Karoonda Area School.

Our Governing Council at a meeting on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2020 has endorsed the following uniform policy. **TBA**

Future amendments are possible providing they fit within the general theme of the Policy. Future amendments can be made by forming a representative committee to make a recommendation to Governing Council.

## Winter Uniform-Boys and Girls

- Polo Top KAS tri-colour shirt.  
**Available from school.**
- Long Sleeved Top White or black skivvy or T-shirt style.
- Skirt/Skort Black [no netball skirts], bottle green tartan, box pleated pinafore top for younger children.  
**Pinafore patterns available from school Front Office.**  
**Material available from Anne Boughen (85783427).**
- Windcheater Bottle green fleecy or polar fleece rugby style with shirt collar with KAS emblem on the front left side.  
**Available from school.**  
(Year 12 Tops accepted)
- Trousers/Jeans Black
- Track Pants Black (discrete logo accepted if no other options)
- Socks White or black
- Shoes/Boots/Sneakers Predominantly white or black  
No thongs **Summer Uniform-Boys and Girls**

- Dress Green and white check, shirtmaker dress, with half belt and short sleeves.
- Skirt/Skort Black
- Polo Shirt KAS tri-colour shirt.  
**Available from school.**
- Shorts Black (appropriate length)
- Socks White or black
- Shoes/Boots/Sneakers Predominantly white or black  
No thongs
- Sandals Practical and safe design with back-straps  
Neutral colours (no bright colours or accessories)

## Sports/PE Uniform-Boys and Girls

- Students (Years 5-12) are to change from their school day clothes into: Karoonda Area School PE top
- Shoes Sneakers
- Bathers One-piece swimsuit and/or shorts  
Speedo/bathers and/or shorts  
Sun-smart top

Billiatt House-Orange

## Miscellaneous

- Blazers – for important events.
- Hair accessories to be bottle green, white or black.

## Special Note

Bicycle helmets must be worn when cycling, skateboarding, etc.  
Casual Days – appropriate footwear must be worn (no thongs, singlets or shoe-string strap tops are not be worn).

### **Hats**

Bottle green sun-smart hat. **Available from school.**

- No inappropriate logos
- No baseball caps allowed
- No hat: sit in the shed
- Beanies: black, white or bottle green and only be worn to or from school or under a wide brimmed hat in the yard.

### **Jewellery**

A watch is acceptable but must be removed necessary to comply with WHS regulations.

No jewellery to be worn to school with the exception of:

- studs or sleepers - max of 2 piercings per ear
- watch
- Medic Alert bracelets or necklace

My TERN Mentor wristbands are accepted but must be removed when necessary to comply with WHS regulations, as is the same for charity wristbands (but these are only to be worn within a prescribed week).

**Nail Polish** Nail polish is not allowed so as to comply with WHS regulations.

**Make Up** Make-up is not allowed so as to comply with WHS regulations.

### **Please Note:**

For safety reasons, and in line with the DfE WHS policy, students must wear enclosed footwear while participating in lessons in the Home Economics, Agricultural Studies, Technical Studies Centres, The Arts, Science Laboratories and Physical Education lessons.

### **SAPSASA Jumpers**

SAPSASA jumpers can only be worn during the fortnight immediately following participation in a SAPSASA event. Notification of this will be published in the school newsletter.

### **Uniform Consequences**

*Each staff member to query students out of uniform and place green uniform sticker in student's diary.*

*Non-compliance:*

- *Repeatedly not in uniform.*
- *Home group teacher to ring if diary note not signed and still out of uniform or diary note signed but still out of uniform.*
- *Two notes or more per Semester will result in not allowed to be involved in one extra-curricular activity of the schools choosing (eg USE/SAPSASA Sport, Socials, etc) or privileges such as SRC, House Captain, etc.*
