- **Children’s Fiction** – popular authors, novels, graphic novels

- **Magazines** – e.g. Farm Journal, Practical Parenting, Choice, Dolly, Down under Quilts, Better Homes & Gardens

You will need:

- A valid library card (it's quick and easy to join at public libraries across SA)
- Internet access
- A compatible eBook reader, mobile device or computer (Note: Kindle eReader is not compatible)

**Holds:** (previously known as Inter-Library Loans): Library members may either place a hold on an item from the online catalogue [www.libraries.sa.gov.au/mallee](http://www.libraries.sa.gov.au/mallee) OR ask library staff to place a hold for them. When a hold arrives you will be notified by email (if you have provided an email address) or phone call. (Note: *Holds remain on the Holds Shelf for 7 working days—if not picked up within 7 days they will be returned to the owning library.*)

**Over Due Items:** When an item becomes pre-overdue or overdue you will be notified by email (if you have provided an email address) or letter.

Overdue items may be extended either:

- A. By accessing your account online at [www.libraries.sa.gov.au/mallee](http://www.libraries.sa.gov.au/mallee)
- B. Calling the library (8578 1120) to request an extension
- C. Come into the library to request an extension

NOTE: Items borrowed from other SA Public Libraries may incur a fine if they become overdue.

**Services available at the library include:** Free Internet access; computers; photocopying; laminating; scanning of documents/photos; general information; newspapers (The Advertiser, Standard, Border Times)

**Wireless Internet Access:** The Karoonda Community Library offers wireless connection to the SA Public Libraries FREE Internet service. If you are interested in registering, please bring your laptop/device to the library to obtain your login and password.
